Journey of Making a Wooden Log Planter



Step 1: Choosing Sal Wood and Finding the Perfect Size Log The journey began with selecting high-quality Sal wood, known for its durability and strength. The next step was to find a log of the perfect size and shape that will suit the intended design of the planter. This step is crucial as it sets the foundation for the entire project.

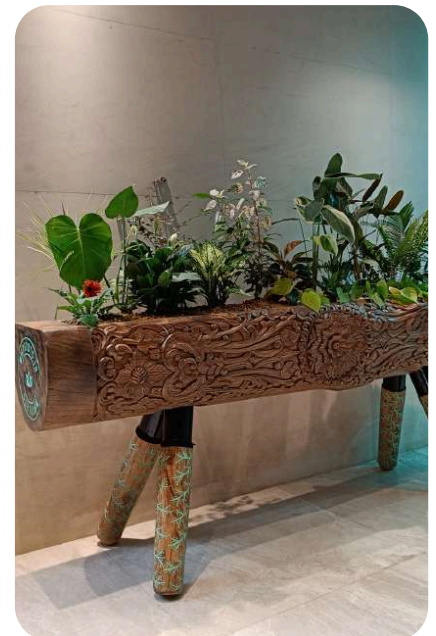
Step 2: Cutting the Log to Desired Shape and Carving Out the Design Once the log was selected, it was carefully cut to the desired shape. This involves measuring and sawing the log to create the basic structure of the planter. After shaping, intricate designs were carved out to add aesthetic value. The carving process required precision and skill to bring out the beauty of the wood.



Step 3: Polishing the Wood After carving, the log was polished to enhance its natural grain and smooth out any rough edges. This step involved sanding the wood and applying polish or varnish to protect the surface and give it a rich, finished look. The polishing process not only improves the appearance but also increases the longevity of the planter.



Step 4: Setting Up Plants The final step was of setting up plants in the newly crafted wooden planter. Soil was added to the hollowed-out log, and plants are carefully positioned to create a harmonious arrangement. The combination of natural wood and greenery created a stunning and functional piece that was later put for display.

What made this project truly remarkable was the integration of nature into the design. After carving the continents, Wild Roots introduced a living element by growing plants directly on the globe. Various types of greenery were carefully selected and planted in specific regions, creating a living map where continents were represented not only by carved wood but also by vibrant, growing plants. The result was a stunning fusion of natural and crafted beauty, symbolizing the connection between the earth and the living world.

The 1540 kg wooden globe by Wild Roots stands as a testament to the artistry and environmental consciousness of its creators, showcasing the beauty of our planet in a unique and captivating way.

Wild Roots embarked on an extraordinary project to create a 5.5 ft tall solid wooden globe, featuring an exact replica of the world map. This ambitious endeavor combined artistry, craftsmanship, and a deep connection to nature.

The globe was meticulously crafted from a large, solid piece of wood. The team at Wild Roots began by carefully shaping the wood into a perfect spherical form, ensuring that the globe was both visually striking and structurally sound. Once the sphere was ready, the intricate work of replicating the world map began.

Each continent was hand-carved into the wood with precision. The artisans paid close attention to detail, capturing the unique shapes and coastlines of the continents, as well as the varying topographies. This process required immense skill and patience, as the wood was delicately chiseled and sculpted to bring the map to life.

The journey began with the Wild Roots team creating a rough design of the globe using digital tools like Paint. This design outlined the final look of the globe, including the placement of continents and the areas where real plants would be grown. The team chose mango wood for this project due to its ease of carving and its suitability for the intricate work required. Mango wood was also selected because it could be chemically treated to ensure a long life, making it durable and resistant to decay. Since the end result involved planting real plants on the globe, the wood needed to be waterproofed to protect it from moisture.



Assembling and Shaping the Globe The treated mango wood pieces were joined together and then cut into various circular sections according to the globe's size. These pieces were carefully assembled to form the spherical shape, ensuring a solid and seamless structure as the foundation for the wooden globe.

To strengthen the structure, an internal metal rod was added to provide support and keep the globe securely together. This reinforcement ensured that the wooden globe maintained its shape and durability over time.



Once all the pieces were joined, the globe took on its spherical shape. It was then carefully finished and sanded to achieve a perfectly smooth surface, making it ready for the intricate engraving of the continents.

After the globe was fully shaped and smoothed, the next step was to accurately draw the continents onto the spherical surface. This required careful measurement and precision to ensure the continents were correctly positioned and proportioned. Once the outlines were in place, the team embarked on the meticulous task of engraving each continent into the wood. This process was both tedious and delicate, requiring great attention to detail and steady hands. Over the course of 26 days, the intricate engraving work was completed, bringing the globe's surface to life with the detailed representation of the world's continents.

Next came the step of initial finishing. The globe was carefully sanded to smooth out the surface. However, painting could not be done at this stage, as the globe needed to be disassembled and reassembled on site. Due to the weight—approximately 1200 kg when fully assembled—the globe had to be made in portions. This allowed for easier transportation and handling, ensuring that the massive structure could be safely moved and reassembled at its final location.



Next, the team focused on creating a wooden stand to support the globe. This stand was carefully crafted to complement the grandeur of the globe.

Artisans hand-carved intricate flower designs into the wood, adding a touch of elegance and artistry. The detailed carvings not only enhanced the stand's visual appeal but also provided a sturdy and aesthetically pleasing base for the globe to rest upon. The craftsmanship ensured that the stand was both functional and a beautiful piece in its own right, perfectly supporting the impressive globe above it.

After the initial finishing of the globe was completed, it was carefully dismantled and packed for transportation. All the necessary equipment required for the final finishing of the piece was also included in the packing. This meticulous process ensured that the globe and its components would arrive safely at their destination, ready for the final touches to be applied.



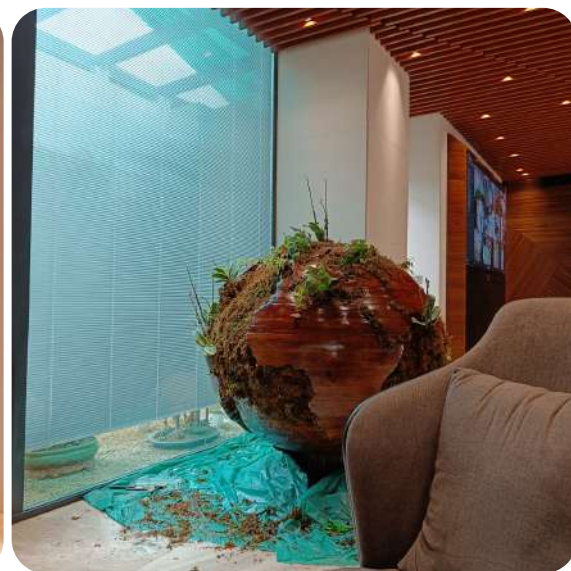

Once the globe reached its destination, the assembly process began. The globe was carefully reassembled, ensuring that all the internal layers were properly aligned and securely tightened using an internal rod. This step was crucial to maintaining the structure and stability of the globe.

Next, the final coating of polish was meticulously applied to enhance the wood's natural beauty and provide a smooth finish. Following the polish, a waterproofing coat was added. This protective layer was essential to prevent the wood from absorbing water, ensuring the durability and longevity of the globe planter.

The final step in the creation of the wooden globe planter involved applying live plants to the outer shell. To prepare the surface, an additional layer of epoxy coating was applied, ensuring a durable base for the plants. Once the epoxy layer was set, dried moss was carefully adhered to the areas representing the sea, adding a natural texture to the globe.



Next, live plants, along with their planters, were meticulously attached to the wooden surface in a way that made it appear as though the plants were naturally growing from the wood. This step required precision to seamlessly integrate the plants with the globe's design.

After the plants were securely in place, regular watering and initial maintenance were carried out. Over time, the plants adapted to the outer shell of the globe, thriving in their new environment. This successful integration allowed the plants to flourish, completing the transformation of the globe into a living, growing piece of art.
